Greene Class!

Phonics, high frequency words and tricky words at home

We haven't introduced any new tricky words this week but keep practicing last week's words! Our new phonic sounds are included as well, to practice the actions and the letters at home.

Reading

Please make sure to record any reading in your child's reading record. When reading, we have been focusing on our segmenting and blending in class. If your child struggles to segment or blend a word, please demonstrate it to them, breaking the word into its phonic sounds to say each sound out individually. Then blend it together and see if your child can see the word!

English

In English we will be continuing to look at traditional tales, extending our work on The Gingerbread Man. We will then compare our traditional tales, before creating our own ones.

Maths

In maths this week we are starting our new topic of addition and subtraction! If counting at home, make sure the children are counting slowly and accurately. We have practiced putting our fingers on each object as we say the number, allowing us to accurately count every time.

Science

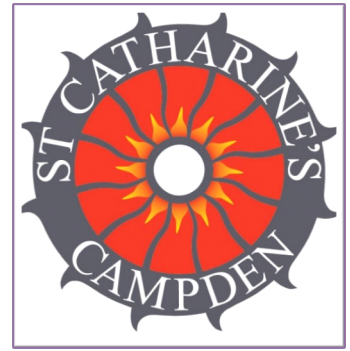
