Nativity

Everyone should have received a copy of the Nativity script. We have chosen one with as little dialog as possible, with most of the dialog being repeated throughout. If possible, please talk through your child's part with them, and rehearse their line. You can use the script to help them understand when they need to talk! We will be practising more and more over the coming weeks, and learning our songs over and over!

Phonics, high frequency words and tricky words at home

We have included our new tricky words and fairy (high frequency) words. Some of these we have only just started looking at, and the children may need reminding!

Reading

Please make sure that when recording reading in your child's reading record, to include a comment on what they struggled with or what went really well; and to indicate how far through the book you have read. This really helps when choosing the next book, and reviewing their progress.

When reading, we have been focusing on our segmenting and blending in class. If your child struggles to segment or blend a word, please demonstrate it to them, breaking the word into its phonic sounds to say each sound out individually. Then blend it together and see if your child can see the word.

English

In English we will be continuing to look at traditional tales, completing our work on The Gingerbread Man. Following a delay due to looking at the snow (!) and our fantastic trip, we will be comparing traditional tales, before creating our own ones.

Maths

In maths this week we are continuing our topic of addition and subtraction, using these skills within our play, as well as guided activities, making sure to draw on our good counting skills.

Science

We are continuing to look at 'Light and Dark' in science, and we will be looking at different types of lights and their meanings, tying it into our road safety work from last week.
