

Weekly overview: wb 1st October 2018

In English, last week we created a class Funnybones story-map with actions and worked on sequencing pictures. This week we will be finishing with Funnybones and making our own story maps to show our understanding!

We are continuing to learn 'All about Me', and we will be starting to look at different senses. We will also be looking at and talking about younger photos of us. **Please bring in a younger photo by Wednesday (3rd October), that we can display in our class.**

Also, on Wednesday, is the cake sale! Each cake costs 25p and can be bought after school. Your children can either bring money in in the morning, or you can accompany your child after school.

Our maths focus this week is number, by counting and doing one more and one less. We will be using objects (to 10 and 20) in different situations, with different resources, and in our play.

This week we will be continuing with our phonics phase 2 sounds, completing the initial SATPIN set of sounds. Reading books will be changed Monday, Wednesday and Friday, depending on if needed. It is also great to re-read books, as it continues to develop understanding. There are questions inside of your child's reading record to help with developing understanding.
